INDIAN CREEK COUNTRY CLUB HISTORY

The course was originated in 1925 by a group of Marion and Cedar Rapids businessmen who formed a corporation and called themselves the Marion Club.

In 1935 the course was sold to Claude Knapp who operated it until 1940 at which time Bud Connell took over the operation. In 1945 the name was changed from Marion Country Club to its present name.

In 1949 Nu-Marion Corporation who leased the premises to Olde Indian Creeke Country Club purchased the property.

In 1971 the members of Olde Indian Creeke Country Club purchased the Club from Nu-Marion Corporation. At a special meeting of the certificate holders on August 1, 1976, it was voted to build a new clubhouse and facilities. The new clubhouse was opened in February 1977. During the summer of 1977 the fairway watering system and new well were installed and two newly constructed tennis courts were put to use.

The ownership changed in the fall of 1988 to the investor group of North Marion Investors, Inc.

Golf Club Management from November 1988 to December 1996 leased Olde Indian Creeke Country Club.

From 1996 to 2008 B & J Catering, Ltd. operated Indian Creek Country Club.

As of 2008 a group of individuals know as Creeke Bed Investors, LLC purchased the club. It will as a private golf club with dining and limited use of the golf course, swimming pool available to the public.

SITE

Indian Creek Country Club consists of 44 - 2/3 acres and is located at the site of the old Marion Interstate Fair Grounds. At its inception, it was necessary to play between the fair buildings and during two weeks of each August it was necessary to close the course and fence off the greens to permit the yearly fair to take place. The racetrack is still discernible.

COURSE

The 9-hole course is 2,759 yards long, par 34 with bent grass greens. The course is laid out so that a minimum of walking is necessary and one can easily play nine holes in an evening by starting as late as 6:30 PM. Indian Creek Country Club is a member of the U.S.G.A. and the Iowa Golf Association.

MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

FULL FAMILY

Entitles full use of all Club facilities for husband, wife and all unmarried children living at home under the age of 24 and are full time students.

FULL JUNIOR FAMILY

Entitles full use of all Club facilities for husband, wife and all unmarried children living at home under the age of 24 and are full time students. The oldest spouse must be 35 years old or younger.

FULL SENIOR FAMILY

Entitles full use of all Club facilities for a husband and his wife. The oldest spouse must be at least 60 years of age to qualify for this membership.

SINGLE

Entitles full use of all Club facilities for an individual. This type of membership does not include the use of the Club facility for any spouses or children.

SENIOR RESTRICTED

Entitles full use of all Club facilities Monday through Friday only for an individual who is at least 60 years of age.

SOCIAL

Includes full use of the Club's dining room and bar facilities as well as the swimming pool, for the husband, wife and all children under the age of 24 and are full time students.

NON-RESIDENT

Available only when the member's primary residence is beyond a 50-mile radius of the City of Marion, Iowa. Entitles the member to full use of the Club's facilities.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. Members and their guests shall conduct themselves in an appropriate, courteous and respectful manner.
2. Violations of Club rules shall be reported to the Manager or the Director of Golf.
3. Members are financially responsible for their charges as well as their guests' charges and any damage to club property.
4. Club property will not be removed from the premises.
5. Social members are restricted to the Clubhouse, Swimming Pool and Tennis Courts.
6. All food and beverages must be purchased from the Club.
7. All members are asked to dress in a manner that is acceptable at a private club. **Enforced dress code:** Men, 16 years of age and older, must wear Collared shirts. Women and Children must wear appropriate golf attire.
8. It is illegal to bring any alcoholic beverages on Club property as required by State Law.

DINING ROOM

1. The Club's Dining Room is available for Club functions and events. This room is also available for private use by members and the public. A room rental fee is required.
2. The Club handles all food and bar arrangements.
3. Dining is open to the public.
4. Shirts and shoes are required in the Clubhouse.
5. All tickets are subject to a 15% gratuity.

CREEKE BED

1. The Creeke Bed is open daily during the golf season, except Monday.
2. Members are financially responsible for they're own and their guests' charges and damages.
3. No article shall be offered for sale on Club premises.
4. All returnable items are the property of the Club.
5. The Creeke Bed is not a game or card room for children.
6. Minors are not permitted in the Club during the following times in the Summer Months.
7. The Creeke Bed will close on Friday nights when the last couples group finishes.
8. On Wednesday last call will be at 11:30 pm and the Creeke Bed will close at Midnight.

Tuesdays: Women's Day Before 11:00 p.m. or after 5:00 p.m.

Wednesdays: Men's Day after 12:00 p.m.

Except to purchase food or beverages

CREDIT POLICY

1. Credit shall be extended only to those members in good standing.
2. The amount billed is due in 30 days and becomes delinquent thereafter with a 1 1/2% monthly finance charge applied to the unpaid balance. A minimum finance charge of \$1.00 is applied.
3. **Any account 60 days in arrears shall have their privileges suspended.**
4. Pro Shop credit cannot be applied toward member's account.
5. All charges, in the Creeke Bed or upstairs, are subject to a 15 % gratuity.
6. All Charge disputes must be addressed to the club manager.

GOLF

1. All golfers must register in the Pro Shop.
2. Appropriate golf attire is required. Men, 16 years and older, must wear collared shirts. No cuts off jeans are allowed. Golfers must wear shoes.
3. U.S.G.A. Rules will govern all play. Local revisions will supersede all rules.
4. Groups of five players will be allowed if the players are using 3 carts, except May-Sept.
5. Green fees must be paid for any non-member of Indian Creek Country Club to play.
GUEST LIVING IN LINN COUNTY ARE LIMITED TO THREE ROUNDS PER SEASON. Guest days and open tournaments do not count toward the three round limit.
6. Golf course etiquette is to be used at all times.
7. Golfers must tee off hole #1, unless given permission by the Pro Shop staff.
8. Alternating on holes #1 and #10 will be as follows:
 - Foursomes teeing off #1 are first in line.
 - Foursomes coming of #9, starting #10 are second in line.
 - Alternating continues until #1 tee opens.
9. No one **under the age of 5** is allowed on the golf course.

Juniors will not be allowed to golf during the months of May, June, July, August, and September during the Ladies morning and evening golf times as well as after 11:30 a.m. on Men's Day.

Please review the Junior Restrictions for other restrictions that apply to juniors.

1. An authorized guard must be on duty to use the pool.
2. Members in swimming attire are limited to the pool area only.
3. Guards have full and complete authority over the use of the swimming pool.
4. Behavior that is hazardous is prohibited. Disciplinary action will be handle by the guards.
5. **All children must be of at least 8 years of age to be left unsupervised at the pool.**
6. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
7. Members will be held accountable for the conduct of their children and guests.
8. All posted pool rules will be strictly enforced.
9. Any conduct that spoils the enjoyment of others will not be allowed.
10. *An adult must supervise children using the wading pool.*
11. Radios are not allowed without headphones,
12. The pool will not open if the outside temperature is less than 70 degrees.
13. All guests must register with the lifeguard and pay **\$4.00 guest fee.** **
14. **ALL FOOD OR BEVERAGES MUST BE PURCHASED THROUGH THE CLUB.**

The pool will not reopen if the inclement weather hasn't ended by 4 pm

Wading Pool will close no later than 6:30 pm

Failure to notify the lifeguard of a guest will result in a **one-month suspension from the pool!
